

### HAUNTING OF SMITHVILLE

None of the locals will ever go out in the woods late at night near the old village of Smithville, NJ. When the moon is bright and the winds blow in from the ocean one can even imagine the colonial residents of Smithville shutting their doors and shutters to keep out the night air. But that is not all they wish to keep out. The legend of a dangerous creature named The Jersey Devil is known to lurk in the woods nearby searching for prey. Historic Smithville has been rebuilt to its original quaintness giving tourists the opportunity to become fully enveloped in the experience of a 16th Century village. The principal building is the original and restored Colonial Inn. There is a rumor that within this 30-room establishment a ghost has been seen passing through rooms 201 and 202. The apparition appears to be that of a middle-aged colonial woman who dresses in typical high neck, stiff bodice that buttons, long sleeves, and a full petticoat and cap.

Other buildings that line the dusty streets are two other inns, the Lantern Light and The Barn. Ghost hunters and mediums frequent the village hoping to connect with a restless spirit or ghost. Reports of paranormal activity involving two young girls who were burned in a bakery fire have been recorded during one such visit by local paranormal investigators Nina Circone and Paula Nebbagui, and medium Lisa Wolff.

The New Jersey Pine Barrens, with their carnivorous plants and creepy burned pine trees surround this ghostly town off the Garden State Parkway. So if you ever want to learn more of the history of the village of Smithville, NJ, take a ghostly tour one evening. But remember to bring your imagination and your flashlight because you might even get a glimpse of the terrifying New Jersey Devil.



#### How did you begin your journey in to music?

My interest in being a musician came on pretty early when I bought an electric guitar around the age of 10, but it never really grabbed me so I kind of fell out of the idea for a few years. 

Addison is 8 years old. She loves to read, dance, sing, and play video games!





# Artist of the Month

# <u>Micheal Hurst</u>

#### Charcoal on Wood Panel Drawings

I am currently working on a new series of drawings that are portraits of people I know in Cincinnati. Each person holds an arrow and an object. The object represents something they love. I tell the participants that the object "doesn't have to represent what they love the most, just something they love." The arrows represent cupid's arsenal.

The idea for this body of work was born from a lecture I attended a few years ago. The speaker told the crowd that "It's easy to make artwork about pain and struggles, injustices and raw deals. It's much harder to make something about positivity." This quote has stayed with me ever since and rings out in my head while making every drawing.

I wanted to make a series that represented love, but also represent the city of Cincinnati in an attempt to promote the value of community. I asked for volunteer models on social media and got an overwhelming response. The process is quite simple. I go to thrift stores and rummage shops to find ornate frames to buy and from those I cut wood panels to fit them. I stain the wood and make the work with charcoal, chalk and eraser. The style is inspired by Italian Renaissance painter's cartoons and underpaintings. I wanted a stripped down look for this series in hopes that it would create a more honest sense of emotional than my previous paintings could.

At this point, not counting drawings I've done in this style for fundraisers or for experimenting, I have 8 finished/ framed pieces in this series called Love Letters. My goal is to have 12 finished/ framed pieces in this series which I'm currently doing sketches and photography for. In between the Love Letter drawings I do "one-off" drawings to work on my craft and to practice new techniques. Some of these pieces wind up being my favorites even if they're never shown or even finished.

### Heart Shaped Lobster Ravioli for 2!

## Catrina's International Catering with Chef Sal

- 1 box of Lobster Ravioli
- 1 Quart container of Heavy Cream
- 8 oz. of Grated pecorino Romano cheese
- quarter stick of Butter
- 1/2 bunch fresh basil
- In a medium saucepan take 3 thirds of a quart of heavy cream and pour it in
- Leave on medium heat and let it cook for 5 minutes stirring occasionally.
- While that's cooking take the basil and make sure it's washed and patted dry and chop it fine.
- Next take the basil and put it in with the heavy cream and lower the flame and stir .
- After you have done that take a quarter stick of butter and 4 oz of the grated cheese and add to your sauce and stir.
- (A wooden spoon is recommended for this to stir with) Add a pinch of salt and pepper to taste.
- Now while your basil cream sauce is cooking on a low flame in another pot put up the water to boil the raviolis. Add a pinch of salt to water and let boil.
- When the water is boiling add the raviolis and give one nice careful stir to the raviolis to make sure they don't stick. It should take about 5 to 7 minutes for the ravioli to be done.
- All the while your doing this you need to keep stirring your basil cream sauce. Your sauce should be ready in about 15 minutes. Salt and pepper to taste
- When the sauce is done, remove from heat and add the other 4 oz of grated Romano cheese and stir.
- Drain water out of Ravioli
- After you have drained all the water from the ravioli place them on either one big plate or 2 plates and then take a ladle or large spoon and pour your cream sauce over the ravioli to your liking!! ENJOY AND HAPPY VALENTINE'S DAY!
